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# Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by length of residency in Coronado, housing tenure, presence of children 17 or younger in the household and age of respondent.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as “excellent” or “good,” or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A “p-value” of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are “real.” Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for all respondents (447) is generally no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent. The margin of error for subgroups is less precise. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- For the most part, when looking at residents who had lived in Coronado for different lengths of time no clear pattern emerged for ratings across all three pillars of community livability. However, residents who had lived in Coronado for more than 20 years displayed the highest levels of Community Engagement within Participation (for example, participating in clubs or attending City meetings).
- When significant differences in ratings between homeowners vs. renters occurred, residents who owned their homes almost always gave more positive ratings than those who rented their homes.
- Residents who did not have children 17 or under in their homes tended to give more positive ratings than those with children in their homes.
- It was difficult to discern broad patterns among residents of different age groups, although differences in perception were observed. However, like longer-term residents, Coronado residents aged 55 or older displayed higher rates of Participation within Community Engagement than younger residents.
