Country Club/Parker Basin Area Storm Line Infiltration Project

The City of Coronado invites sealed bids for the **Country Club/Parker Basin Area Storm Line Infiltration** project. This project generally consists of installing new 18", 24", 36", 42", and 48" CIPP liners with hydrophilic end seals, new lateral to main watertight seals, injection grouting, and sealing active infiltration at structures; existing 36" pipe repair, removal and replacement of existing 18"/24" pipe including, excavation, trench shoring and dewatering, and AC pavement/concrete surface restoration.

**Receipt of Bids:** All bid proposals must be received by the City Clerk at City Hall, 1825 Strand Way, Coronado, California 92118 PRIOR TO 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 15, 2016.

**Engineering Estimate:** \$1,400,000.

**Pre-Bid Conference:** A pre-bid conference will be conducted at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 3, 2016, at City Hall, 1825 Strand Way, Coronado, California.

**Bid Security:** Bid Security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the Lump Sum Base Bid shall accompany the Bid.

**Contractor's License:** The successful bidder will be required to possess a current State of California "Class A" Contractor's License at the time the Contract is awarded.

**Prevailing Wage:** In accordance with the California Labor Code, the Contractor must pay not less than prevailing wage rates as determined by the Director of Industrial Relations for all work done under this contract.

**Bid Documents:** Copies of the plans, specifications, CCTV inspections (on DVD), instructions to bidders and bidder's proposal forms are available from the Public Services & Engineering Department, 1825 Strand Way, Coronado, California 92118. Contractors may also request an electronic version of the plans and specifications by contacting the Public Services & Engineering Department; the CCTV inspection DVDs must be purchased as they are too large to download; the cost (non-refundable) for the DVDs alone is \$12.00, including postage.
