Waiver of Liability and Express Assumption of the Risk

RELEASE FROM LIABILITY: In consideration of the acceptance of myself to be a participant (as either a driver or a rider) in the Coronado Senior's Out and About Program (hereinafter referred to as "the Program"), I, _____ (name) expressly agree and knowingly assume all risks arising in the course of the Program, including but not limited to, personal injury, property damage or death, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, and hereby voluntarily release, discharge, waive and relinquish any and all claims and causes of action from personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against the City of Coronado, its agents, officers, and employees which may occur during my participation in the Program.

I hereby agree for myself, my heirs, administrators, executors and assigns that I shall indemnify and hold HARMLESS the City, its agents, officers and employees for any injury, death or damage to or loss of personal property arising out of, or in connection with, my participation in the Program. I also hereby agree, for myself, my heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, that I shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Coronado, its agents, officers, and employees from any and all claims, demands, actions or suits arising out of or in connection with my participation in the Program, including any and all claims, loss, damage and liability for injury to their person or property or another or others, directly or indirectly caused by any misfeasance or malfeasance by me occurring while participating in the Program. This release is intended to discharge in advance the City of Coronado, all other city agencies and/or any of their agents, volunteers or employees by reason of any accident, death, injury or damages to persons or property which I may suffer, from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in the Program, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above.

CODE OF CONDUCT: In consideration of the benefits of the program, I agree to abide by the Code of Conduct set forth in this section. I understand that this Code of Conduct ensures the quality and safety of the program, and that all program participants, staff, and volunteers are required to abide by this Code. The Code of Conduct states that: "All persons shall act with respect toward others, observing their privacy and safety. Physical or verbal abuse of any kind will not be tolerated and will result in the participant being asked to leave the program. All persons shall show respect

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to the property of others; intentional damage to, or theft of, such property or program equipment will result in the participant being asked to leave the program. Program rules and regulations shall be observed at all times. While staff is committed to having the participant enjoy the experience, inappropriate behavior may result in a participant being asked to leave. Drugs and alcohol affect the ability to drive or operate a motor vehicle and all drivers understand and agree that the use of any drug or alcohol which may affect their driving ability. As such, the use of drugs and/or alcohol prior to 8 hours before participating as a driver in the Program is strictly prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, prescription, or "over-the-counter" medication and alcohol and all drivers understand and agree to not use any drug or alcohol that may affect their driving ability." No refunds will be given in the event that a participant is asked to leave the program for violating the Code of Conduct.

VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPH RELEASE: I understand and agree that the City of Coronado reserves the right to take and use videos and photos of participants, free of charge, to be used for publicity purposes in the City's program guide and/or other media publications.

ELDER ABUSE MANDATED REPORTERS: I understand that City Parks and Recreation Department staff may be required by state law to report any suspected cases of elder abuse or neglect to the appropriate authority for investigation.
