PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD SET
FOR THE
November 8, 2016
GENERAL ELECTION

STATE LAW PROVIDES FOR A "PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD" OF ALL CANDIDATES' BALLOT OCCUPATIONAL DESIGNATIONS, CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS, AND OTHER MATERIALS BEFORE PRINTING THE SAMPLE BALLOT AND VOTER INFORMATION PAMPHLET.

THE CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE FURTHER DEFINES THIS REVIEW PERIOD, WITH A DISTINCT PERIOD FOR EACH DOCUMENT FILED WITH THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS.

DURING THIS PERIOD, ANY VOTER WHO BELIEVES ANY PORTION OF THESE MATERIALS TO BE FALSE, MISLEADING OR INCONSISTENT WITH STATE LAW MAY SEEK A WRIT OF MANDATE OR INJUNCTION REQUIRING ANY OR ALL OF THE MATERIAL TO BE AMENDED OR DELETED.

The public review periods are as follows:

Ballot Occupational Designations for Local Candidates*

August 13 to August 22

Candidates filed by August 12

August 18 to August 29

Candidates filed by August 17, (during the 5-day extension)

Candidates' Statements of Qualifications for Local Offices*

August 13 to August 22

Statements filed by August 12

August 18 to August 29

Statements filed by August 17, (during the 5-day extension)

U.S. Senator, Congress, State Senate, State Assembly.**

NOTE:

The dates for any of the incorporated/charter cities may be different (PLEASE CONTACT CITY CLERK FOR DETAILS).

All documents will be available for public review at the Registrar of Voters office during regular business hours.



CANDIDATE STATEMENTS

The Nomination Period for Candidates for the position of Mayor is from July 18 through August 12. The Public Review Period for Candidate Statements and Ballot Designations for the position of Mayor is from August 13 through August 22.

The Nomination Period for Candidates for the position of Councilmember is from July 18 through August 17. The Public Review Period for Candidate Statements and Ballot Designations for the position of Councilmember is from August 18 through August 29.
